AutoShape	A group of ready-made shapes that include lines, connectors, basic shapes, arrows, flowchart symbols, stars and banners, and callouts.	163
Cell	The space where a row and a column intersect in a table.	152
Chart	A graphical display of information.	166
Clip Art	Images that can be inserted into a document.	158
Column	Two or more vertical sections on a page.	148
Column break	Separation of text from one column to the top of the next column.	149
Datasheet	A table that stores information shown in a chart.	166
Diagram	A graphic that represents or illustrates information.	162
Graphic	A visual element created using tools such as WordArt, AutoShapes, scanners, and digital cameras.	163
Sizing handle	Points on a small square around a selected object that can be dragged to change the object's size.	160
Table	A set of rows and columns used to organize information.	151
Text box	A movable, resizable rectangle that contains text.	160
WordArt	Text graphic that can be stretched, shadowed, and shaped.	165

You can change the width of a column by pointing between the two columns until the pointer becomes a double-headed arrow. Double-click the arrow to automatically fit the column to the width of the text.
