Create a new blank layer named <i>Gradient</i> .			
Use the Color Picker to change the foreground RGB settings to 249, 247, 182.			
Use the Gradient tool to make the foreground color transparent and create a gradient that covers the screen.			
Change the Gradient layer blending mode to Color.			
Key <i>Stonehenge</i> in 36 pt Papyrus font. Use Figure 5.32 to size and position the text.			
Select the Text and Stonehenge layers and Align Horizontal Centers.
