Create a new layer and name it <i>New Car</i> . Hide the <i>Original Car</i> layer.			
Create a copy of the <i>New Car</i> layer. Rename the new layer <i>Reflection</i> .			
Flip the image vertically. Drag the inverted car below the other car. Line up the tires of the cars.			
In the Layers palette, move the Reflection layer below the New Car layer.			
Create a new black layer and drag it below the <i>Reflection</i> layer in the Layer's palette.			
Adjust the contrast of the <i>New Car</i> and <i>Reflections</i> layers.			
Insert the speedometer image into the car document. Name the new layer <i>Speedometer</i> and move it below <i>New Car</i> in the Layer's palette.			
Follow Figure 5.26 to move and resize the speedometer. Erase the part of the speedometer below the car.
