**Employees: The Key to Success** Human resources are the people employed in a business. Employees are also referred to as personnel. They provide the skills, knowledge, labor, and experience needed to make a business productive. Human resources managers work as recruiters. Recruiters try to find the right person for a job. They also help people develop as employees so they can do their jobs well. Human resources managers begin the recruitment process by writing a job description. The job description is included in ads for the job.

- **background check** The process of verifying certain information provided by a job applicant
- **reference** Someone who comments on a job applicant's character and qualifications for a job
