What's New

AutoCAD 2008 introduces new features and several enhancements to existing capabilities. You will notice the following differences in *Applying AutoCAD 2008*:

- A new default workspace called 2D Drafting & Annotation has been added. You will become familiar with this workspace and the other two default workspaces as you work through the lessons in each chapter.
- The new 2D Drafting & Annotation workspace employs a new Dashboard containing panels and toolbars for drawing and dimensioning in two dimensions, while new panels and features improve the Dashboard for the 3D Modeling workspace.
- New dimensioning capabilities are introduced, including a new Multileader tool and easy alignment and spacing control of dimension lines.
- New commands and features to control drawing annotations have been added which simplify and improve Multiline text, text styles, tables, and the creation of a bill of materials.
