

# Activity 28

## Design a Room

Design and decorate a room of your choice. Use what you learned in Chapter 13 about the elements and principles of design. Consider your interests and activities as well.

Supplies		
poster board	fabric scraps	paint chips
glue	catalogs showing home furnishings	markers or colored pencils

**Directions:** Decide what kind of room you will design and decorate, then follow the steps below.

1. Develop a color scheme for the room. Will you use light or dark colors? Warm or cool colors? Using markers, fabric scraps, and paint chips, arrange the colors in your color scheme along one edge of the poster board. Glue the samples in place.
2. Choose furnishings and accessories for the room, remembering to maintain your color scheme. Take into consideration your interests, as well as the activities for which the room will be used. Look through catalogs for ideas.
3. Using the floor plan on the next page, sketch in the furniture for the room. Remember to consider the traffic patterns in the room, leaving enough space around furniture so that it can be used comfortably.
4. On the lines below, describe the room and its function. Then describe the mood you wanted to create, the style you opted for, and the furniture you chose. Explain the reasons for your choices.

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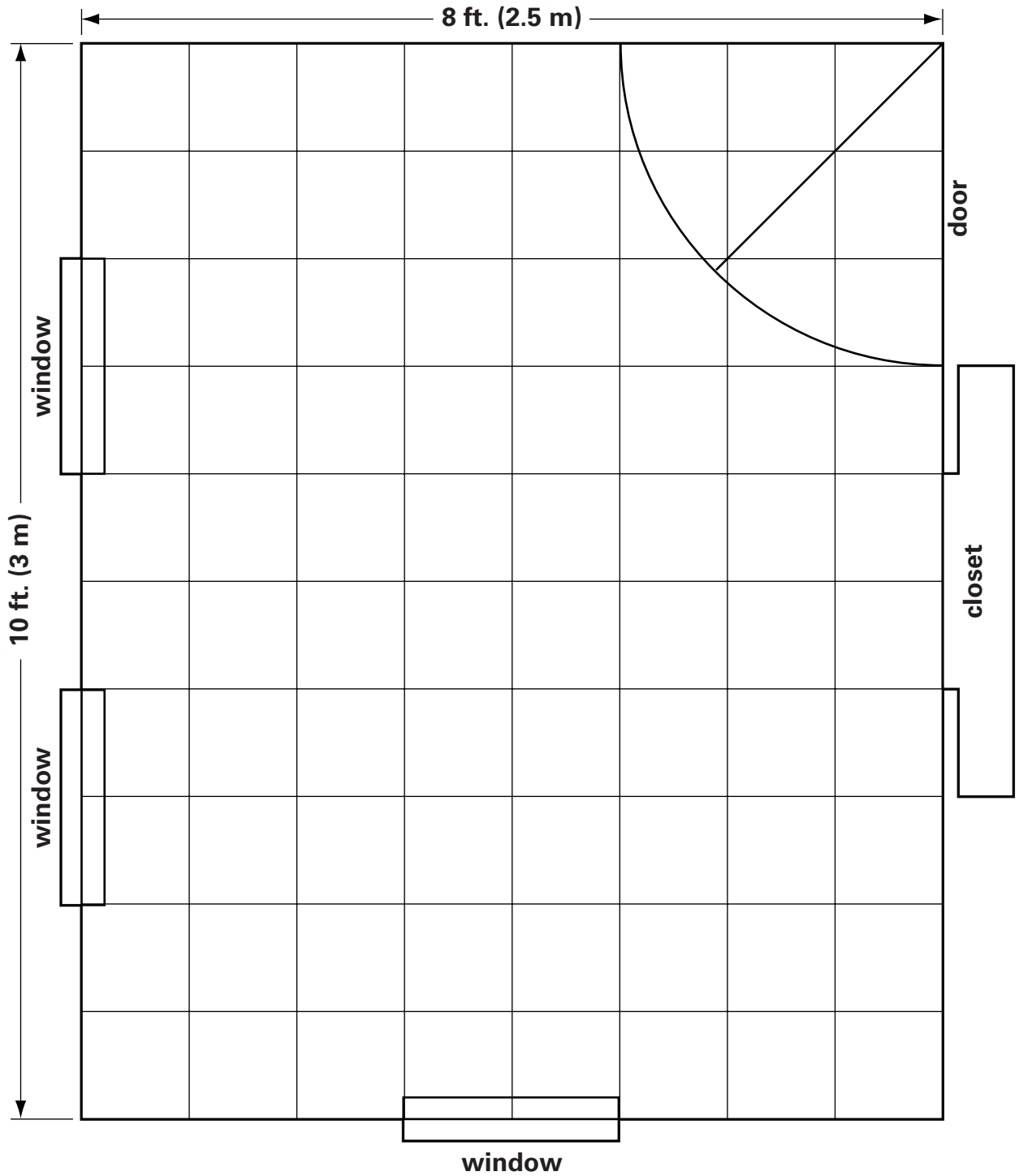
